

Floods:

Recommended advice:

- Pay attention to weather forecasts and the recommendations of the authorities in this regard.
- Check the state of roofs and tanks of water, as well as drains and downspouts.
- Do not park your car in the riverbed of the ravines, although the sky is clear at the time.
- Review and have ready a lantern or candles, kitchen type camping gas in anticipation ok cut electricity. Be prepared with food, drinking water, radio batteries, etc.
- Close and lock windows and doors to prevent the entry of water. Small guards can help protect you in case of flooding.
- Avoid going out hiking or camping until normal weather returns.
- If it is necessary to drive, do it carefully and do not enter that may flood.

Recommended actions:

- Tune in to local radio stations and followed the local instructions for our area.
- If you notice that the storm is accompanied by lightning, close windows and doors, as air currents can attract to hit.
- Unplug electrical appliances to avoid damage by a power surge or injury from an electric shock.
- In case of flood threat, turn off the mains switch to the house.
- If the storm starts when you are driving, reduce speed and use extreme caution as roads can be affected by landslides
- Do not stop at places where large amounts of water may arrive, like ravines, gullies or the foot of a valley.
- If you are in the country avoid sheltering under lone trees or climbing to elevated areas. Stay away from fences, towers and other metallic structures.
- Avoid use of phone in order to avoid lines being hit.
